

# BEER GARDEN PERMIT APPLICATION

Fee: \$15.00

Ordinance 6-3, Permit Required for Beer Garden Outdoor Consumption. No licensee shall permit the consumption of alcoholic beverages on any part of the licensed premises not enclosed within the building, except under a beer garden permit granted by the Village Board. The permits are a privilege in which no rights vest and, therefore, may be revoked by the Village Board at its pleasure at any time or shall otherwise expire at the end of the approved period. No person shall consume or have in his or her possession alcoholic beverages on any unapproved part of a licensed premise which is not described in a valid beer garden permit.

The licensee shall file the application not less than thirty (30) days before the date of the proposed activity or event. The Village Board shall review the application. If the nature of the property or the event requires the imposition of additional regulations, the Village Board may impose these regulations upon an express finding the detailing the reasons for additional regulation.

Limitations on Issuance of Beer Garden Permits. Each applicant for a beer garden permit shall accurately describe the area intended for use as a beer garden and shall indicate the nature of fencing or other measures intended to provide control over the operation of the beer garden. There shall be a licensed operator with the beer garden at all times the beer garden is in operation. The Village Board may approve limited exceptions to the limitations contained in this Subsection upon written application therefore by the Permittee.

Every permittee under this Section shall comply with and enforce all provisions of Chapter 125, Wis.Stat., applicable to Class "B" licensed premiss, except insofar as such provisions are clearly inapplicable. Violation of the provisions of Chapter 125, Wis. Stats., shall be grounds for immediate revocation of the beer garden permit by the Village Board.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of Ordinance 6-3 shall be grounds for suspension, non-renewable or revocation of Licensee's alcohol beverage license or licenses.
